

Board of Health Minutes April 2, 2019 Town of Williamsburg

Meeting called to order at 2pm for Hearing re 10 Dewey Circle

Mrs. Tripp asked the board for the permission to enter the property at 10 Dewey Circle to obtain her financial information for 2015 taxes. In discussion with the board members, she acknowledged that she is in the process of obtaining a building contract and has contacted a contractor but does not have a signed contract as required to lift the order of condemnation. Until that contract is obtained, the Board voted to uphold the condemnation order and Mrs. Tripp is not allowed to enter the property until it is deemed safe by the Building Inspector.

Donna and Helen have been contacted by Steven Jones re writing a letter to the Governor re the hazards of natural gas. At this time, Williamsburg does not have natural gas. Donna will contact him that the Board does not plan to write a letter at this time.
