HINTS FOR COPING WITH STORMS

- Whenever possible, it is best to pile snow to the right of the driveway (as you face the street) to reduce the potential of having it redeposited at the driveway opening when the plow passes.
- When clearing driveways, snow should be kept on the owner's property. Snow should not be deposited onto the street or sidewalk, or across the street onto someone's property.
- To avoid having to do the job twice, shovel the driveway after the storm has passed and the street has been cleared.
- Prevent street flooding by clearing catch basins near your home to allow rain or melting snow to enter the drainage system.
- Older residents and/or persons with health problems should consult a physician before shoveling snow.
- To protect the safety of you and your neighbors, shovel and clear fire hydrants of snow in your neighborhood.
- It is strongly advised if you live on a hilly road To have snow or studded snow tires on your vehicle .
