Meeting called to order at 7:03 p.m.

- 1. (wt) handed out some data from Northampton regarding the sewer discharge rates. The Board discussed what the numbers mean.
- 2. Nehring, 16 Walpole Road-wants to tie-in the sugar house into an existing line that already extends onto his property. Mr. Nehring asked about the fee. The Board discussed that no fee would be charged as he already paid for the initial fee and is tying into his own line, not at another curb stop. Motion made and seconded to waive any fee for this tie-in. Motion so voted.
- 3. Meter Station on South Main Street-It has been observed that many people are parking at the property to bike ride or use the river for swimming. The board noted that neighbors are complaining, trash is being left, and there is graffiti on the metering station building. Motion made and seconded to post the property "No trespassing" and "No parking". Motion so voted.
- 4. Camera work-Eastern Pipe found a large cracked pipe on High Street, in the Anne T Dunphy parking lot, and some issues at the James School.
- 5. Sump Pump letters-still working on getting them out. Will put in a sixty-day allowance to fix the pumps that have been found.
- 6. Sewer testing updates-(wt) is talking to the Brewer at 4 Main Street. He is trying to figure out the approach to lower the TSS & BOD. Bread Euphoria's plan is unknown at this time.
- 7. Motion made and seconded to sign the water and sewer warrants. Motion so voted.
- 8. Motion made and seconded to accept the Minutes from 4/9/19 & 4/23/19 as written. Motion so voted.
- 9. Motion made and seconded to authorize (jh) to spend up to \$500 to have large water service and sewer service maps printed up. Motion so voted.

Motion made and seconded to adjourn the meeting. Motion so voted. Next meeting will be 5/28/19.
