**Housing Issues:** 

23 Old Goshen Road waiting for estimate of oil clean up at site estimate has been given of \$40,000. Receiver has agreed to pay for this. Waiting for bank approval of plan:

3 Myrtle Valerie has appointment on Monday with the wiring inspector and building inspector as there might be a problem with the wiring and may have to be replaced. Cost of this is unknown, pending further inspection.

125 Old Goshen Road property is now vacant and has been posted Valerie received a complaint that needle box in the public restroom at Cumberland Farms could be accessible for children. Valerie made an inspection. Board recommended that store provide a container that has a more protective shield. Valerie will call the company that provides this service for the store and see if one is available

2 B Chesterfield Rd. Valerie is making inspection as she received complaint that mold have been found in the basement.

**Transfer Station Issues** 

Report that the TS Lock is broken. Rusty will investigate and remedy.

Budget for 2017 was discussed. Appears that the budget will be level funded. It was voted to add \$750 for an officer to accompany Valerie when she makes visits for housing complaints. Currently rusty is doing this but it could be a police officer if available. Rusty has been doing this on his own time and is much appreciated by the Board.

It was voted to reduce the Public Health Nurse line to \$2000 as to date these services have not been required and the money is returned to the Town when not utilized.
