Meeting Minutes – April 23, 2020
Meeting via Zoom

Commissioners present - Mary Dudek, Todd Lynch, and Joe Rogers

Members of the public present - Jesse Porter-Henry

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm

RDA for 25 Nash Hill Road regrading: The area in question is in the 100-200 foot zone of the riverfront. Mr. Porter-Henry presented a plan for regrading and adding topsoil to a steep, rocky lawn. He would also like to make a smooth path for a lawn mower and tractor: no topsoil would be added. No vegetation will be removed, and straw wattles will be in place for erosion control. Commissioners Dudek and Rogers had done a site visit to the site, and had no concerns about erosion. There is still a lot of buffer zone between the project and the river. Commissioners issued a Negative 3 determination with the following conditions: Erosion controls will stay in place around the perimeter of the work area until soil is stabilized. Commissioners will be notified and given the option to inspect the site after erosion controls are in place and before they are removed.

Update on GIS Project: Commissioner Rogers met with Polly, the GIS student working with the Commission to fulfill an independent study. There is not a lot of product yet, but she is working on a dynamic map with a Story Board. What do we want the public to know? What do we want to showcase?
