Meeting called to order at 10:00 a.m.

1. The committee discussed with Patrick Roche of the Metro Area planning Council (MAPC) (Mr. Roche participated telephonically) a program in which the Town could be reimbursed for up to 30% of the cost of the purchase and installation of LED street lights. Replacing the current street lights with LED equipment would result in a lamp wattage reduction of 50% and reduction in the annual energy cost for the street lights by 50%. The net cost to the Town to replace existing street lights would be approximately \$27,024.00, with a payback of 3.8 years. The MAPC would assist the Town in purchasing and project management. The committee encouraged the Town to participate in this program. K. Boas stated that he had prepared information for the Capital Planning Committee's consideration and for inclusion of a warrant article for Town Meeting in June 2017.
2. G. Mann moved to adjourn the meeting. R. Stinson second. Approved, so voted 5-0. Meeting adjourned at 11:25 a.m.
