RELATIVE TO PROPOSED ZONING BY-LAW AMENDMENTS

PURSUANT TO M.G.L. c 40A, §5

A Public Hearing will be held on Monday, February 25, 2019 at 7:30 PM at the Williamsburg Town Offices Auditorium, 141 Main Street, Haydenville, MA to discuss the proposed general and zoning bylaw changes summarized below. A draft of the full text of each proposed Bylaw change may be viewed at the Town Clerks Office during her regular business hours or online at www.burgy.org

Summary of Transient Lodger Bylaw, a General Bylaw:

Defines the difference between Short-Term Rentals in a Single-Family Dwelling and a Lodging Facility. Establishes a registration and licensing procedure. Requires annual health and fire inspections and the maintenance of a guest register.

Summary of Establishments for Transient Lodgers, a Zoning Bylaw:

Requires Short-Term Rentals in a Single-Family Dwelling to be within the primary residence of the owner or leaseholder. Limits rentals to a maximum of four bedrooms per dwelling, with no more than two adults per bedroom, and a maximum of ten persons at any one time. Maximum length of rental to be no more than 30 days. Sets off-street parking requirements. Special Permit required for all zones.
