Project Completion

Greetings from the Public Safety Complex Building Committee. We are here to bring you another update on progress at our new Public Safety Building. We are nearly complete with just a few fine touches left to do! At this point the contractor is wrapping up finishes such as paint, flooring, plumbing finishes, electrical finishes, ceilings, and equipment. All building systems will soon be thoroughly tested and inspected. To finish things off, a new epoxy floor coating will be applied to the equipment bay and police garage. Epoxy not only looks terrific, it ensures maximum durability against the heavy use anticipated by the departments and provides a safe working surface. Next spring the landscape plantings will be installed as well as the main building signage.

Project Solar Progress

Although the general construction is nearly complete, the Building Committee is still actively working on the solar design that will be installed next spring by a separate solar contractor. The state awarded the Town a substantial grant to implement both roof and canopy-mounted solar panels that will power the building's entire electrical load during most times of the year.



The Building Committee and project team are thrilled with the outcome, and we hope the community shares this sentiment. The entire design concept for this building was to remain cost-conscious, practical, and modest while respecting the historical fabric and context of downtown Williamsburg. We believe the goals established by the design and management team, Building Committee, and public safety departments have been met.
