## Answers to Frequently Asked Questions for the Proposed Public Safety Building, Williamsburg, MA

**Q24, Why is the Westhampton public safety complex larger than ours but less costly? A.** The two plans are different in a large number of factors which make it hard to compare Westhampton to Williamsburg. One major factor is that Westhampton is using a preengineered building, inherently less costly per square foot, but that look is not considered appropriate for such a prominent town center location as we have. Westhampton itself has accepted some risk and cost that we are not, such as doing the building demolition. Our \$5.1 million figure includes <u>all</u> activities, i.e., taking down the school building, asbestos abatement and related structural fill, plus construction contingencies, equipment, fees, OPM costs, code required testing, etc.
