Hampshire SS:

To the Constable of the Town of Williamsburg

Greetings:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town, qualified to vote in elections and in Town affairs, to meet at the Earl F. Tonet Gymnasium in the Anne T. Dunphy School, 1 Petticoat Hill Road, in said Town on Monday, the twenty fourth of February, in the year Two Thousand twenty, at seven o'clock in the evening, then and there, to act on the following articles.

**Article 1 To see if the Town will vote** to raise and appropriate, or transfer from available funds the sum of \$30,000 to supplement funds previously appropriated for the fiscal year 2020 Local School budget to support educational services at the Anne T. Dunphy School, or take any other action relative thereto.

**Article 2 To see if the Town will vote** to raise and appropriate, or transfer from available funds the sum of \$180,000 for the purpose of extending the Owner's Project Manager contract, hiring a licensed design consultant to complete architectural plans for a public safety complex, and conducting an engineering and environmental study of the Helen E. James building, and any other incidental and related expenses to the public safety complex and/or the Helen E. James site, or take any other action relative thereto.

And you are hereby directed to serve this warrant by posting up attested copies hereof in at least five places in said Town fourteen days before the date thereof, as within directed.

Hereof, fail not, and make due return of this warrant, with your doings thereon, to the Town Clerk, at the time and place of meeting as aforesaid.
