HRHS WILLIAMSBURG STUDENT TRUST FUND APPLICATION

Background:

The Town of Williamsburg is fortunate to have been remembered in the wills and bequests of many residents who have left to benefit specific groups or to further important goals. Our public schools, in particular, have benefited from this generosity beginning in 1858 with the will of Dr. Daniel Collins. Much of the revenue generated by the education trusts is used to support programs at the Williamsburg elementary school. However, funds are also available to HRHS students who live in Williamsburg.

As custodians of these funds, the Trust Fund Commission would like to invite you to apply for education-related support.

Application Guidelines:

Upon receipt of an application, the Williamsburg Trust Fund Commission will evaluate the proposal. Funds are not awarded on the basis of financial need, but on educational value. Please provide specific information regarding how the funds will be used. For the Computer Program, the more detail provided and the clearer the educational purpose, the greater the likelihood that the application will be approved. The Commission reserves the right to request additional information in order to make their evaluation.

Basic Eligibility

- The student must reside in Williamsburg.
- He or she must be a student at HRHS at the time of application and during the time for which the funds are requested.
- The funds are to be used for educational purposes.
- No student is eligible to receive more than \$350 in any given year.

Eligible Expenses

- Funds are for one-time expenses that enhance the student's education at HRHS. Please note that this excludes the cost of ongoing lessons and classes.
- *The educational opportunity must be sponsored by HRHS.*
- Funds will be granted for the academic year (which includes the following summer) in which the funded event takes place.
- Fees and dues—for example, membership dues or competition entry fees—are not eligible.

Computer Program

The Trust Fund will provide \$200 toward the purchase of a computer to any Grade 7 student, for use in his or her education at HRHS.

- The criteria for basic eligibility—as described above—must be met. The \$350 annual limit includes any funds awarded under the Computer Program.
- The student must be in the 7th Grade at HRHS.
- The primary use for the computer must be for the student's education.
