Articles 1 through 2 of the Special Town Meeting.

Hampshire SS:

To the Constable of the Town of Williamsburg

Greetings:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of said town, qualified to vote in elections and in town affairs, to meet at the Earl F. Tonet Gymnasium in the Anne T. Dunphy School in said town on Tuesday, the second of March next, at seven o'clock in the evening, then and there, to act on the following articles.

Article 1 **To see if the Town will vote** to transfer the sum of \$20,037.50 from the FEMA Reimbursement Account to Highway Road Maintenance, or take any other action thereon.

Article 2 **To see if the Town will vote** to transfer the sum of \$4,200 from the FEMA Reimbursement Account to Highway Garage/Equipment Maintenance, or take any other action thereon.

And you are hereby directed to serve this warrant by posting up attested copies hereof in at least five places in said town fourteen days before the date thereof, as within directed.

Hereof, fail not, and make due return of this warrant, with your doings thereon, to the Town Clerk, at the time and place of meeting as aforesaid.
