**HRHS WILLIAMSBURG STUDENT TRUST FUND APPLICATION**

**Background:**

The Town of Williamsburg is fortunate to have been remembered in the wills and bequests of many residents who have left funds to benefit specific groups of to further important goals. Our public schools, in particular, have benefited from this generosity beginning in 1858 with the weill of Dr. Daniel Collins. Much of the revenue generated by the education trusts is used to support programs at the Williamsburg elementary school. However, funds are also available to HRHS students who live in Williamsburg.

As custodians of these funds, the Trust Fund and Cemetery Commission would like to invite you to apply for education-related support.

**Application Guidelines:**

Upon receipt or an application, the Williamsburg Trust Fund and Cemetery Commission will evaluate the proposal. Funds are not awarded on the basis of financial need, but on the educational value. Please provide specific information regarding how the funds will be used. The more detail provided and the clearer the educational purpose, the greater the likelihood that the application will be approved. The Commission reserves the right to request additional information in order to make their evaluation.

*Basic Eligibility*

- The student must reside in Williamsburg.
- The student must be a part of the HRHS school district at the time of the application and during the time for which the funds are requested.
- The funds are to be used for educational purposes.
- No student is eligible to receive more than \$350 in any given year.

*Eligible Expenses*

- Funds are for one-time expenses that enhance the student's education at HRHS. Please note that this excludes the cost of ongoing lessons and classes.
- Fees for Advanced Placement exams.
- *The educational opportunity must be sponsored by HRHS.*
- Funds will be granted to the academic year (which includes the following summer) in which the funded event takes place.
- Fees and dues are not eligible. This includes club membership dues or competition fees.

**Computer Program**

The Trust Fund will provide \$250 toward the purchase of a computer to any student, for use in their education at HRHS.

- The criteria for basic eligibility - as described above - must be met. The \$350 annual limit includes any funds awarded under the Computer Program.
- The student must not have received a grant for a computer from the Williamsburg Trust Funds prior (One time only).
- The primary use for the computer must be for the student's education.
