- c. To maintain the building sewer at no expense to the Town.
- d. To install and maintain an approved oil or grease separator and/or sand trap when it is required by the Sewer Commission.
- e. To notify the Sewer Commission when the building sewer is ready for inspection and connection to the public sewer, but **not before** any portion of the work is covered.
