- 1. David Nehring from 16 Walpole Road wants to tie-in his sugar house to the town sewer. Question of the price. Commission in agreement of a \$500. - 2. Northampton Sewer Regulations-(wt) wants them rewritten with reference to the Town rather than the City, and Commission rather than Superintendent. Also add some wording regarding grease traps in Section 4. The secretary will work on the conversion for the next meeting.
- 3. Proposal for new Municipal Sewer Agreement with Northampton. The Commission tentatively agrees in principle with Northampton's proposal after the presentation. The Commission agreed to have Northampton proceed with drawing up the proposal with the terms spelled out in the presentation but reserves the right to run it by Tighe and Bond and the town Attorneys to protect the interests of the Town before signing. - 4. Land Use Regulations-Nothing to report.
- 5. Capital Plan-Commission needs to look at rates from area towns. Rates will need to increase. Commission will continue to discuss at future meeting.
