Staff of the Massachusetts Historical Commission (MHC) have reviewed the architectural drawings and site plan that was submitted by R. Levesque Associates, Inc. for the project referenced above.

The proposed project consists of the demolition of the commercial bank building at 142 Main Street and the construction of a drive-through restaurant. The information provided indicates that the project will require an access permit from the Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MADOT).

Review of the MHC's *Inventory of Historic and Archaeological Assets of the Commonwealth* indicates that the project is located within the Haydenville Historic District (WLM.A) is listed in the State and National Register of Historic Places.

After review of MHC's files and the information submitted, MHC has determined that the proposed project will have "no adverse effect" (950 CMR 71.07(2)(b)(2)) on the Haydenville Historic District.
